



Cavendish Road State High School Good Standing Policy

The **Good Standing Policy** for Senior Students reflects Cavendish Road State High School's core values of Commitment, Challenge, Courtesy, Consideration and Cooperation. It reinforces the school's culture of high expectations of students in the senior phase to consistently demonstrate responsible conduct, sustained engagement and to make positive contributions to the school. By doing so Senior students have access to opportunities and privileges in recognition of their schooling milestone, and rite of passage. Being of Good Standing

- signifies the maturity, integrity and diligence expected of all students completing senior studies.
- is granted to all senior students by the Executive Principal upon recommendation of teaching staff and is presumed at first issue in either Year 11 or Year 12.
- determines a student's eligibility to participate in senior privileges and certain extracurricular activities, including
 - the wearing of the Senior Jersey,
 - participation in major senior events, including the Year 12 Formal,
 - study at home on Wednesday afternoons,
 - and other activities requiring absence from class is by invitation from the Executive Principal.

It is each student's responsibility to uphold this status through their daily choices, conduct and engagement. Good Standing may be withdrawn where the requirements are not met, the school will outline the expectations that must be met for reinstatement. Good Standing may be restored once the student demonstrates sustained improvement and compliance with the required standards and are expected to:

- a) Maintain an acceptable attendance rate and unless there are extenuating circumstances which have been documented and meet the standards of roll marking in State school's policy. Students with less than 95% attendance can expect intervention or support as the case requires.
- b) Wear the school uniform to a high standard at all times.
- c) Comply with the behaviour expectations as outlined in the Student Code of Conduct and conduct themselves in the broader community with dignity and respect for others when identifiable as a student of the school.
- d) Complete and submit on time all homework tasks, assignments and other assessment items as per the school's assessment policy, and maintain Academic Integrity.
- e) Approach their studies in a diligent manner, access available support services if needed, demonstrate personal accountability for academic and vocational outcomes, study routines and committing to work in an increasingly independent manner.

Students who do not meet the expectations of this policy may lose their Good Standing. Loss of Good Standing may result in ineligibility for senior privileges and participation in extracurricular events. Students who retain Good Standing, will be presented at Graduation with a Certificate of Good Standing to include in their Senior Statement folio and may be used as evidence of endorsement for post-school purposes.
