You may be aware that your child has commenced their year 10 Careers Education Program. This is happening during period 1 each Friday.

During this online work students learn more about themselves, their interests, skills and areas of work that may interest them. Each week students will be expected to complete a number of modules in the program. Each class' teacher will let the class know which modules need to be completed each lesson. In order to be ready for SET P these need to be finished each week. This program concludes with a one page Career Snapshot. This will be presented, along with their SET P, at the SET P interview.
