Consistent with our Strategic Plan 202/23 and Annual Implementation Plan priorities for 2022:

This funding will be used to

- Enhance and continue to align progress in Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN literacy and numeracy proficiency to A-C in English and Mathematics to achieve:
 - o 99% of students at or above national minimum standard in all domains,
 - \circ >30% of students in the upper two bands of all domains.
- Support all students to transfer literacy and numeracy proficiency to meet and exceed student learning goals across the curriculum.
- Monitor and measure gains in individual learning. Student achievement targets to meet or exceed:
 - $_{\odot}$ >95% of students achieving A-C across the curriculum program and
 - \circ >70% of students in years 7 to 10 achieve A or B in their curriculum program

Our initiatives include

- Continue to develop the "Learning@Cav" pedagogical approach of visible teaching & learning.
- Transforming the school's Resource Centre/Library to develop student reading, writing, collaboration and research skills, and access to digital and analogue resources.
- Further progress differentiation and inclusion in repertoires of teaching practice supporting teachers in professional learning teams to acquire, apply and model these skills to effect learning growth.
- Targeted interventions safety-netting learning for target groups where required to ensure one year's learning growth for every child after one year's instruction.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employing additional staff to provide additional individulaised education service, targeted student support, and extension & enrichment for the full range of student abilities.
- Providing professional learning of and for authentic pedagogy for the full range of learners to engage and progress.
- Enhancing the curation of teaching materials, diagnostic tools, lesson design, and student activities.
