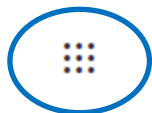
There are a number of steps required to prepare BYO devices for connection to the BYOD network (called onboarding).

1. Ensure your device meets specifications

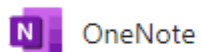

2. Install Microsoft Office

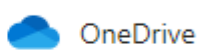
Student sign into Webmail (webmail.eq.edu.au) using their school email address and password. Select the 9 dots and then Office and follow the instructions.



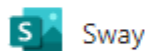

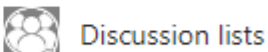

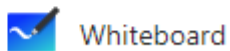

3. Ensure you login into your EQ OneDrive and use this as your default data storage

Your DATA is the most valuable item on the laptop and OneDrive is the best place to store all files as this ensures automatic backups are in place.
